Five Year History for Top 10 Trade Lanes for Imports via Savannah (Calendar Year)

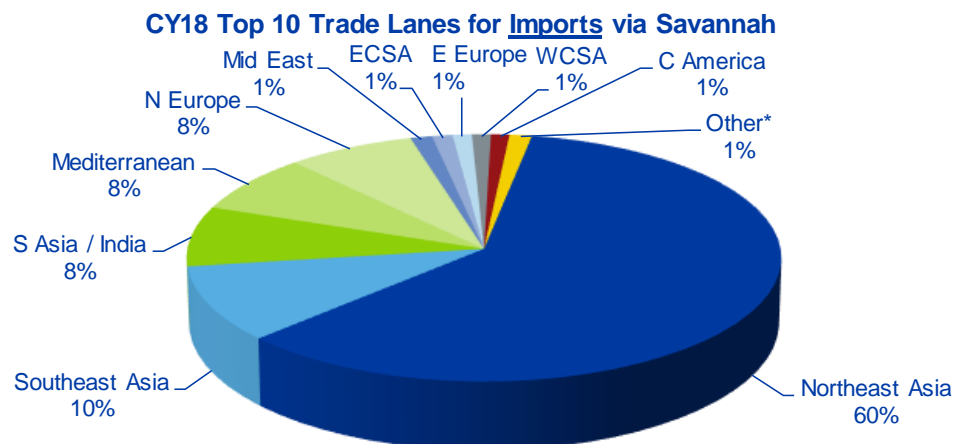
Detail Summary:

- Northeast Asia was the largest trade lane for imports via Savannah during Calendar Year 2018 (CY18) and had the most growth between CY14 and CY18, increasing by 443,080 TEUs.
- Other trade lanes with rapid growth between CY14 and CY18 were Southeast Asia (+75,418 TEUs), North Europe (+70,036 TEUs), Southern Asia/Indian Subcontinent (+63,316 TEUs), and the Mediterranean (+48,715 TEUs).
